CHURCH LIGHTS - As part of our careful stewardship of money
we have made several differences this year which you will have
read about previously. You may also remember we asked for sug-
gestions as well. Each change in itself may not increase income by
much or reduce expenditure by much, but together they are making
a difference. You already know we are limiting colour copying,
using paper instead of card (where possible), making a more real-
istic charge for 'outside' copying services, encouraging at least 50p
for a cup of coffee, charging heating costs (when used) for wed-
dings and funerals, increasing number of adverts in magazine and
increasing the cost of magazines (they now break even). And, we
continue to encourage more people to sponsor the weekly pew
sheets which are so valued by all our congregation. One more
suggestion is for all those who work on the various tasks in
church to decide how much lighting is needed and to only switch
on what is actually required as we would at home (and switch off
after using that area). As an example the south aisle chandeliers
contain 48 bulbs, the central aisles 48 bulbs and the north
aisle 18 bulbs. Imagine paying for that number of bulbs (114) at
home! This was a good suggestion and well received. Any other
income increasing and expenditure decreasing ideas would be
gratefully received.
